



Maintaining your new Golf green

Daily/Weekly Maintenance

1. Sweep the green as needed. Use a medium to soft bristled push broom. Frequent sweeping may stand the turf fibers up. If the ball starts to “hop” while putting, roll out the green as directed below.
2. As an option, use your leaf blower. Keep the blower at a low angle to avoid blowing sand out of the turf.

Monthly Maintenance

1. If necessary, use a small (20 – 30 gal.) lawn roller filled with water to roll out your green. Avoid unnecessary rolling, as the turf can be damaged by frequent over rolling. Roll your green on a sunny, warm day to speed up this process.

Annual Maintenance

1. Check to see that the cups are adjusted to the correct height. Cups should be seated about 1/8” below the top of the green. Cup hooks are available from Midwest Putting Greens for a nominal fee.
2. Top dressing your golf green may be necessary, depending upon usage and weather. If necessary, we recommend you arrange with Southwest Greens - Mn to perform this service. Rolling after top dressing will be necessary.
3. Southwest Greens - Mn suggests that your golf green be rolled once yearly. See above for instructions, or call Midwest Putting Greens for a quote on a Maintenance Contract.
